
ORDER DENYING PETITION

This emergency petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges an order of the district court denying petitioner's motion to strike additional language and counts from the amended information and the denial of petition's motion to reconsider. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Sally L. Loehrer, Judge. Petitioner has also moved this court for an emergency stay of the trial set to commence on May 14, 2007.

Having reviewed the petition and the supporting documentation, we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way

of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹ Accordingly, we deny the petition. Further, we deny petitioner's request for a stay.
