

ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges district court orders holding petitioners Tom and Michelle Danson in contempt and imposing sanctions against them.

Mandamus is an extraordinary remedy, and it is within this court's sole discretion to determine if such a petition will be considered.¹ Generally, a writ of mandamus is not available unless the district court manifestly abused its discretion.² A petition for a writ of mandamus is a suitable means by which to obtain this court's review of the district court's

contempt and sanctions orders,³ but the petitioners bear the burden of demonstrating that this court's intervention is warranted.⁴

We have considered this petition, the answer, and the supporting documentation, and we are not satisfied that our intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted. In particular, we are not persuaded that the district court manifestly abused its discretion in finding the Dansons in contempt of its September 2003 order and in directing them to remove or relocate the garage in question.⁵ Accordingly, we.

ORDER THE PETITION DENIED.⁶
