ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal. Seventh Judicial District Court, White Pine County; Dan L. Papez, Judge.

On November 9, 2007, we entered an order that, among other things, granted appellant's motion for an extension of time to file his civil proper person appeal statement and directed appellant to effect proper service of his notice of appeal on respondents' counsel. That order gave appellant thirty days from the date of that order to file and serve his civil proper person appeal statement and fifteen days from that order's date to properly serve his notice of appeal and file a properly completed certificate of service in this court. Our November 9 order further cautioned appellant that his failure to file his civil proper person appeal statement within that time period or to comply with our directives regarding the service of his notice of appeal may result in the dismissal of his appeal. Appellant's certificate of service was due on November 26, 2007, while his civil proper person appeal statement was due on December 10, 2007. To date, appellant has not filed either the certificate of service or his civil proper

person appeal statement with this court. Accordingly, we conclude that appellant has abandoned this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
