ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a petition for a writ of mandamus. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Steven P. Elliott, Judge.

Appellants filed a petition for a writ of mandamus in district court, challenging a justice court order refusing to disqualify a justice of the peace. The district court concluded that writ relief was not warranted because the affidavit of disqualification was not properly served and the challenged justice of the peace permissibly evaluated whether service was proper. This appeal followed.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law especially enjoins as a duty resulting from an office, trust or station¹ or to control a manifest abuse of discretion.² Mandamus



will not issue when a plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law exists.³ Mandamus is an extraordinary remedy, and the decision as to whether a petition will be entertained lies within the court's discretion.⁴ We review a district court's decision to grant or deny a petition for a writ of mandamus for an abuse of discretion.⁵

Having reviewed the briefs and the record, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in refusing to grant extraordinary relief. Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
