ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS PETITION


This original petition for writ of prohibition or mandamus challenges an order of the district court allowing a real party in interest to withdraw his guilty plea to a felony DUI charge.


On October 24, 2007, the real party in interest filed a motion to dismiss the petition. Petitioner opposed that motion. However, on June 2, 2008, petitioner filed its own motion to dismiss indicating that the matter has become moot. Specifically, petitioner indicates that the real party in interest, Jorge Alberto Orozko-Nava, has entered a guilty plea and that the district court entered a judgment of conviction on May 23, 2008.


Cause appearing, petitioner's motion to dismiss is granted and


ORDER this petition DISMISSED.


