## ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court's order denying petitioner's motion to disqualify opposing counsel. Petitioner has also filed an emergency motion requesting a stay of trial, which is set for October 22, 2007.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires as a duty resulting from an office, trust, or station,<sup>1</sup> or to control a manifest abuse of discretion or an arbitrary or capricious exercise of discretion.<sup>2</sup>
