


ORDER DISMISSING PETITION



On July 2, 2008, the parties filed a stipulation to voluntarily dismiss the petition without prejudice. Accordingly, we dismiss the petition. Further, we lift the stay of all pending warrants of execution


entered by this court on October 15, 2007.




