ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order dismissing appellant's complaint. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Susan Johnson, Judge.

Appellant's appeal was placed in this court's pilot program for civil proper person appeals on February 25, 2008. At that time, appellant was mailed a civil proper person appeal statement and other documents, as part of the pilot program. See ADKT No. 385 (Order Establishing Pilot Program in Civil Appeals, June 10, 2005); see also ADKT No. 385 (Order Extending Pilot Program for Civil Proper Person Appeals, May 10, 2006) (extending the pilot program for civil appeals, which was scheduled to conclude on June 13, 2006, until further order of this court). As noted in this court's February 25, 2008, order, appellant was required to file her appeal statement within 40 days. The order further explained that if appellant failed to file the appeal statement by that date, this court would dismiss the appeal. Id.

Appellant's appeal statement was due on April 7, 2008. To date, appellant has not filed an appeal statement or otherwise responded to this court's directive. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
