## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order dismissing appellant's complaint. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Susan Johnson, Judge.

Appellant's appeal was placed in this court's pilot program for civil proper person appeals on February 25, 2008. At that time, appellant was mailed a civil proper person appeal statement and other documents, as part of the pilot program.
