## **ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE**

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a guilty plea, of attempted murder with the use of a deadly weapon. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Steven R. Kosach, Judge. The district court sentenced appellant Melvin Dosdos Dulcero to serve a term of 60 to 180 months in prison, with an equal and consecutive term for the use of a deadly weapon.

The sole issue raised in this appeal is whether the district court erred in refusing to apply ameliorative amendments to the deadly weapon enhancement statute that took effect after Dulcero committed the underlying offense but before he was sentenced. We recently considered this issue in <u>State v. District Court (Pullin)</u>, holding that the 2007 amendments to NRS 193.165 do not apply to offenses committed before

the effective date of the amendments.<sup>1</sup> Consistent with our decision in <u>Pullin</u>, we conclude that <u>Dulcero's argument lacks merit</u>. Accordingly, we ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.
