## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a default judgment in a forfeiture action. Second Judicial District Court, Las Vegas; David Wall, Judge.

Appellant's notice of appeal was transmitted by the district court and filed in this court on December 20, 2007. When the notice of appeal was filed, appellant was mailed a civil proper person appeal statement and other documents, as part of the pilot program for proper person civil appeals.<sup>1</sup> As noted in the instructions accompanying the documents mailed to appellant, appellant was required to file his appeal statement within forty days from the date that his appeal was filed in this

court.<sup>2</sup> The instructions further explained that if appellant failed to file the appeal statement by that date, this court would dismiss the appeal.<sup>3</sup>

Appellant's appeal statement was due on January 29, 2008. To date, appellant has not filed an appeal statement or otherwise responded to this court's directive. Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal.

It is so ORDERED.4
