

## ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a guilty plea, of robbery with the use of a deadly weapon. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Jennifer Togliatti, Judge. The district court sentenced appellant Demetrius Andrew Watson to serve a prison term of 48 to 180 months, with an equal and consecutive term for the use of a deadly weapon.

The sole issue raised in this appeal is whether the district court erred in refusing to apply the ameliorative amendments to the deadly weapon enhancement statute that took effect after Watson committed the underlying offense but before he was sentenced. We recently considered this issue in <u>State v. Dist. Ct. (Pullin)</u> and held that the 2007 amendments to NRS 193.165 do not apply to offenses committed before the effective date of the amendments.<sup>1</sup> Consistent with our decision

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA in <u>Pullin</u>, we conclude that Watson's argument lacks merit. Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.
