## ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION

This original petition for a writ of prohibition or mandamus challenges a district court order that granted a temporary restraining order pending the district court's consideration of real parties in interest's request for a preliminary injunction.

On January 25, 2008, we entered a temporary stay of the district court's temporary restraining order, which was set to expire on February 6, 2008, pending our receipt and consideration of any opposition. Thereafter, on March 17, 2008, we entered an order noting that, in the meantime, the temporary restraining order apparently had expired and

the district court may have resolved the underlying matter. Accordingly, we directed petitioners to, within ten days, show cause why our temporary stay should not be vacated and this petition dismissed.

To date, petitioners have not responded to our show cause order. Accordingly, as it appears that the relief requested in this writ petition is not appropriate, given the apparent resolution of the underlying matter, and that, in any case, petitioners have abandoned pursuit of any writ, we dismiss this petition.
