ORDER DENYING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE
AND DISMISSING APPEAL

Docket No. 34596 is an appeal from a district court order granting a permanent injunction and an order requiring appellant to execute a bout agreement. Docket No. 35147 is an appeal from a subsequent judgment entered in the same district court case. On December 21, 1999, appellant filed a motion to consolidate these appeals. In light of our disposition of the appeal in Docket No. 34596, we deny the motion to consolidate.

On December 27, 1999, we ordered appellant to show cause why the appeal in Docket No. 34596 should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Specifically, it appeared that the notice of appeal from the order granting the

The bout agreement obligated appellant to fight for respondent in a boxing match held on August 7, 1999. Appellant's participation in the boxing match may have rendered moot any issue regarding the order requiring appellant to sign the bout agreement.

On January 26, 2000, appellant filed a response to our order in which he consents to the dismissal of the appeal in Docket No. 34596 for lack of jurisdiction. Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider the appeal in Docket No. 34596, and we dismiss that appeal.

It is so ORDERED.
