

ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks a writ directing: (1) the district court to reinstate petitioner's right to a direct appeal; (2) the district court to order the production and delivery to petitioner of requested chemical tests, transcripts, files, and other relevant court documents; (3) the court reporter to produce and deliver to petitioner the requested transcripts and other relevant court documents; (4) the district court clerk to deliver to petitioner the requested case files and documents; (5) former trial counsel to promptly deliver the entire case file; (6) the district attorney to serve all pleadings on petitioner in a timely fashion; (7) the district court to appoint counsel, other than the Public Defender's Office, to represent petitioner in post-conviction proceedings; and (8) any other relief deemed necessary.

We have considered the documents submitted in this matter, and we conclude that no relief is warranted.¹ Accordingly, we


ORDER the petition DENIED.
