ORDER GRANTING PETITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court decision denying petitioner's request for competency reports. The issues raised in this original proceeding are the same as those recently resolved by this court in <u>Scarbo v. District Court</u>, 125 Nev. ____, ____ P.3d ____ (Adv. Op. No. 12, April 30, 2009), wherein this court held that "prior to a competency hearing held pursuant to NRS 178.415, the court that ordered the examination shall cause full and complete copies of the competency examination reports to be delivered forthwith to the office of the district attorney and to defense counsel, or the defendant personally if not represented by counsel." Consistent with our decision in <u>Scarbo</u>, the petition is granted. The clerk of this court shall issue a writ of mandamus directing the district court to vacate its prior competency findings and conduct a new competency hearing pursuant to NRS 178.415.
