This is an appeal from an order of the district court affirming a justice court conviction. Sixth Judicial District Court, Humboldt County; John M. Iroz, Judge.


This court's preliminary review of this appeal revealed a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, appellant's case arose in justice court. The district court has final appellate jurisdiction over a case arising in the justice court.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, this court ordered appellant's counsel Matthew Stermitz to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. To date, Mr. Stermitz has failed to respond to the order to show cause.


