ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
PROHIBITION OR MANDAMUS

This petition for a writ of prohibition, or mandamus, seeks to preclude the district court from remanding the underlying matter to the Public Utilities Commission (formerly the Public Service Commission).

We have considered the petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. Accordingly, we deny the petition. See NRS 34.330; NRS 34.170; State ex rel. Dep't Transp. v. Thompson, 99 Nev. 358, 662 P.2d 1338 (1983).
