

ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner asserts that on February 15, 2008, he filed a motion to void, vacate, amend and/or correct sentence in the district court and that to this date the district court has not resolved the motion and the State has not filed an answer. Petitioner requests an order directing the district court to treat the State's failure to file an answer as a confession of an error and to grant the motion. We have reviewed the documents submitted in this matter, and we conclude that extraordinary relief is not warranted at this

time.¹ We are confident that the district court will resolve all pending matters as expeditiously as the court's calendar permits. Accordingly, we
