ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order granting respondents' motion for summary judgment. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Susan Johnson, Judge.

Appellant's notice of appeal was filed in this court on May 12, 2008. When the notice of appeal was filed, appellant was mailed a civil proper person appeal statement and other documents, as part of the pilot program for proper person civil appeals.¹ As noted in the instructions accompanying the documents mailed to appellant, appellant was required to file his appeal statement within 40 days from the date his appeal was filed in this court.² The instructions further explained that if appellant
