
ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus in the district court on or about March 21, 2006. Petitioner has filed a number of proper person documents since that date, but claims that the district court has not resolved all of the proper person documents. Thus, it appears that petitioner seeks an order directing the district court to resolve his proper person documents. We have considered the documents before this court, and we conclude that this court's intervention in this matter is not
