This is a proper person appeal from district court orders granting summary judgment. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Steven R. Kosach, Judge.


Appellants Charles King and Priscilla Michael-King filed a complaint against several defendants. Respondent Jack Staten was granted summary judgment on January 4, 2007. Several other defendants appear to have been dismissed on November 14, 2006. However, it is unclear whether all defendants have been dismissed. Moreover, respondent Eastern Pacific's counterclaim against appellants appears to remain pending.


NRAP 3A(b)(1) permits an appeal from a final judgment. A final judgment is one that resolves all claims as to all parties. Lee v. GNLV Corp., 116 Nev. 424, 996 P.2d 416 (2000). Here, some claims remain. Accordingly, no final judgment has been entered, and the orders

appealed from are not independently appealable. See NRAP 3A(b) (listing appealable orders). Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
