ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from an order dissolving a receivership and modifying an injunction.¹ Specifically, appellants challenge that portion of the district court's order requiring appellants to post a bond in the amount of \$350,000 as a condition of dissolving the receivership and modifying the injunction. Appellants stated in their notice of appeal that the appeal was "precautionary," as appellants had already filed a petition for a writ of mandamus challenging the same portion of the district court's order. A writ of mandamus was granted on December 15, 1999. <u>See</u> Womack v. District Court, Docket No. 34742 (Order Granting Petition for Writ of Mandamus, December 15, 1999).

¹On November 17, 1999, the settlement judge filed a report recommending that this appeal be removed from the settlement program. We conclude that the recommendation is moot in light of this order, and disapprove it on that basis.

It appears that this court has not been provided with the addresses of the proper person appellants. Accordingly, we direct the clerk of this court to serve a copy of this order upon former counsel for appellants, Lionel Sawyer & Collins, and direct counsel to provide copies of the order to appellants by mail to their last known address, and to provide proof of service to this court within fifteen (15) days of the date of this order. We conclude that this appeal is moot, as the relief sought has already been granted in the writ proceeding. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal dismissed.
