

ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original proper person petition for a writ of mandamus seeks to compel the district court to file a petition for writ of mandamus submitted to that court and to stay a justice court hearing on whether petitioner should be declared a vexatious litigant until his district court writ petition is resolved.

A writ of mandamus will issue to compel performance of an act required by law, NRS 34.160, or to control a manifest abuse or an arbitrary and capricious exercise of discretion.

Round Hill Gen. Imp. Dist. v. Newman, 97 Nev. 601, 603-04, 637 P.2d 534, 536 (1981). Mandamus relief is generally available only when no plain, speedy, and adequate remedy exists. NRS 34.170. A petition for a writ of mandamus is an extraordinary remedy and whether a petition will be considered lies within this court's sound discretion.

Smith v. District Court, 107 Nev. 674, 818 P.2d 849 (1991). Having considered this petition, we are not satisfied that our intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted, and we therefore deny the petition. <u>Id.</u>; NRAP 21(b).
