


ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS AND  
REMANDING TO THE DISTRICT COURT


Pursuant to the settlement conference, the stipulation of the parties and cause appearing, we dismiss these related appeals. The parties shall bear their own costs and attorney fees. NRAP 42(b).
