## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a judgment of conviction. Our review of this appeal indicates that the district court entered the judgment of conviction on October 2, 1997. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until September 20, 1999, well after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b).
