
ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court denying a motion to correct fraud on the court. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Donald M. Mosley, Judge.

Our review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. The right to appeal is statutory; where no statute or court rule provides for an appeal, no right to appeal exists. Castillo v. State, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990). No statute or court rule provides for an appeal from an order denying a motion correct fraud on the court in a criminal case. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
