ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from an order granting appellant's petition to seal portions of the record pertaining to her criminal record. A review of the record before this court reveals that these portions of the record were sealed at appellant's request. She is therefore not an aggrieved party with standing to appeal. See NRAP 3A(a); Valley Bank of Nevada v. Ginsburg, 110 Nev. 440, 874 P.2d 729 (1994). Additionally, to the extent that appellant seeks this court's review and reversal of her Nebraska conviction, we are without jurisdiction to consider such a request. U.S. Const. art. IV, § 1.

Accordingly, as we do not have jurisdiction over this appeal, we

ORDER this appeal dismissed.<sup>1</sup>
