ORDER REFERRING COUNSEL TO THE  
STATE BAR OF NEVADA AND DISMISSING APPEAL

On January 20, 2010, this court entered an order imposing a \$500 sanction on appellant, Stephen Bowers, a Nevada licensed attorney, for his failure to comply with previous orders. Our January order gave Mr. Bowers seven days from the order's entry to comply with our sanctions and to provide proof that he has paid the \$500. To date, Mr. Bowers has failed to comply with our order or provide proof of payment of the sanction or communicate with this court in any way. Given Mr. Bowers' dilatory actions, we refer him to the State Bar of Nevada for investigation and appropriate disciplinary action.
