## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order setting aside a divorce decree, dismissing a complaint and amended complaint for divorce and awarding attorney's fees to respondent. We have reviewed the record, and we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion. See Cook v. Cook, 112 Nev. 179, 912 P.2d 264 (1996) (holding that a district court's decision to grant or deny a motion to set aside judgment under NRCP 60(b) will be reviewed for an abuse of discretion); Sprenger v. Sprenger, 110 Nev. 855, 878 P.2d 284 (1994) (holding that an award of attorney's fees in a divorce action lies within the district court's discretion); NRCP 60(b); NCRP 41(e). Accordingly, we
