## ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order requiring petitioners to respond to real parties in interest's discovery requests.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires or to control a manifest abuse of discretion.

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA <u>See</u> NRS 34.160; <u>Round Hill Gen. Imp. Dist. v. Newman</u>, 97 Nev. 601, 637 P.2d 534 (1981). Mandamus is an extraordinary remedy, and it is within our discretion to determine if a petition will be considered. <u>Smith v.</u> <u>District Court</u>, 107 Nev. 674, 818 P.2d 849 (1991). Although extraordinary writs are generally not available to review discovery orders, we have issued such writs to prevent improper discovery in two situations—when the trial court issues a blanket discovery order without regard to relevance or the discovery order requires disclosure of privileged information. <u>Clark County Liquor v. Clark</u>, 102 Nev. 654, 730 P.2d 443 (1986). As the discovery order at issue in this case does not fall under either of these exceptions, we conclude that our intervention by way of extraordinary relief is not warranted. <u>Id</u>. Accordingly, we order the petition denied. NRAP 21(b)(1); <u>Smith</u>, 107 Nev. at 677, 818 P.2d at 851.

It is so ORDERED.
