
ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court purportedly denying a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Seventh Judicial District Court, White Pine County; Steve L. Dobrescu, Judge.


Appellant filed a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus challenging the forfeiture of credits as the result of a 2007 prison disciplinary hearing. On May 18, 2009, the district court entered an interim order directing: (1) the State to have an affidavit filed regarding the reason the prison disciplinary hearing officer denied appellant's witness, and (2) petitioner to file a response 20 days later. The district court further denied the State's motion to partially dismiss as moot, the State's opposition to motion to amend, appellant's motion to strike, appellant's request for transcript as moot, appellant's motion for contempt of court, and appellant's motion for order to show cause. On September 3, 2009, the district court granted the petition and directed the Department of Corrections to restore the credits forfeited. Appellant then filed this appeal.

Based upon our review of the documents submitted, we conclude that this appeal must be dismissed. Appellant was not aggrieved by the district court's September 3, 2009 order. NRS 34.575(1) (setting forth the appeal provisions for habeas corpus petitions). Any issues relating to the intermediate decisions made by the district court were rendered moot by the September 3, 2009 order granting the petition. Because appellant failed to designate an appealable order, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
