ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR


WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a district court order denying petitioner's motion to dismiss a wrongful death action on summary judgment, based on the exclusive remedy provisions of the Nevada Industrial Insurance Act.

We have considered the petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. Accordingly, we deny the petition. See NRAP 21(b); NRS 34.170; 34.330; State ex rel. Dep't Transp. v. Thompson, 99 Nev. 358, 662 P.2d

1338 (1983); see also Smith v. District Court, 113 Nev. 1343,
950 P.2d 280 (1997).
