ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

Bar counsel for the State Bar of Nevada has petitioned this court to enter an order temporarily suspending attorney Peter A. Perry from the practice of law pursuant to the provisions of SCR 111. The petition is documented with a certified copy of a judgment of conviction entered against Perry on September 28, 1999. Perry was convicted in federal district court in the District of Nevada, pursuant to a plea agreement, of one count of wire fraud, a felony under 18 U.S.C. § 1343. Perry was sentenced to six months in a community confinement center, to be followed by three years of supervised release. Perry was also fined.

Having reviewed the petition and the supporting documentation submitted by bar counsel, we conclude that the petition conclusively establishes Perry's conviction of a serious crime warranting temporary suspension. See SCR 111(1), (2), and (3). Accordingly, we temporarily suspend Perry from the practice of law and refer this matter to the Northern Nevada Disciplinary Board for the initiation of

formal disciplinary proceedings in which the sole issue to be determined is the extent of discipline to be imposed. See SCR 111(4).

It is so ORDERED.¹
