
ORDER TRANSFERRING MOTION AND
ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING DOCKET NO. 55282

On January 20, 2010, appellants/petitioners filed a document entitled "Motion for Stay Pending Appeal and Original Writ Proceeding," in Docket No. 55282. Although the January 20 document's title suggests that appellants/petitioners were attempting to institute an original writ proceeding, from our review of the January 20 document's text, it appeared that appellants/petitioners intended to file it as a stay motion in

the appeal pending in Regency Partners, LLC v. BACM 2005-6 Decatur Apartments, Docket No. 55274. We thus directed appellants/petitioners to show cause why Docket No. 55282 should not be administratively closed, with the January 20 document refiled as a stay motion in Docket No. 55274.

In response to this court's show cause order, appellants/petitioners' counsel filed a declaration and supplemental declaration, on March 5, 2010, requesting that (1) this court construe the January 20 document as a stay motion in Docket No. 55274 and (2) allow appellants/petitioners to file a petition for extraordinary writ relief in Docket No. 55282. In the declarations, counsel indicated that the petition for extraordinary relief would be filed within two days from the date of the declarations. To date, however, no such petition has been filed. Accordingly, the clerk of this court shall refile the January 20 "Motion for Stay Pending Appeal and Original Writ Proceeding" as a stay motion in Docket No. 55274 and administratively close Docket No. 55282. Any opposition to the stay motion in Docket No. 55274 must be filed and served within ten days from the date of this order.

It is so ORDERED.
