ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order denying a petition for a writ of mandamus that sought to compel respondent to provide appellant with copies of public documents under NRS 239.010. First Judicial District Court, Carson City; James E. Wilson, Judge.

The district court denied petitioner writ relief after determining that the information appellant sought was privileged and confidential under NRS 213.1075 and NRS 49.095. Having review the record in light of appellant's proper person civil appeal statement and respondent's response,<sup>1</sup> we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion when it determined that writ relief was not warranted. NRS 34.160; Round Hill Gen. Imp. Dist. v. Newman, 97 Nev. 601, 637 P.2d 534 (1981) (noting that a writ of mandamus may issue to control a manifest abuse of discretion, and that this court reviews a district court's decision


to deny a petition for a writ of mandamus for abuse of discretion).
