ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE


This is an appeal from a district court order sustaining a challenge to appellant's candidacy for justice of the peace in Las Vegas Township, Department 14, and directing the removal of appellant's name from the ballot.¹ Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; James Bixler, Judge.


Having reviewed the briefs and appellate record, and heard oral argument, we conclude that the district court properly concluded that appellant Amber Lynn Candelaria's name should not appear on the ballot


