ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a minute order dismissing appellant's complaint. No appeal may be taken from a minute order. *Rust v. Clark Cty. School District*, 103 Nev. 686, 747 P.2d 1380 (1987). A notice of appeal filed before the entry of a formal written order is of no effect. Id.; see also NRAP 4(a)(1). Here, the notice of appeal was filed before the entry of a formal written order. It is thus of no effect, and fails to confer jurisdiction on this court.

Accordingly, as we lack jurisdiction over this appeal, we

ORDER this appeal dismissed.¹
