ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR RESIGNATION

This is a joint petition by the State Bar of Nevada and attorney Greg R. Nielsen for his resignation from the Nevada bar.

SCR 98(5) provides that Nevada attorneys who are not actively practicing law in this state may resign from the state bar if certain conditions are met. The petition includes statements from state bar staff confirming that no disciplinary, fee dispute arbitration, or client security fund matters are pending against Nielsen; and that he is current on all membership fee payments¹ and other financial commitments relating to his practice of law in this state. <u>See</u> SCR 98(5)(a)(1)-(2).

Bar counsel has recommended that the resignation be approved, and the Board of Governors has approved the application for resignation. See SCR 98(5)(a)(2). Nielsen acknowledges that his resignation is irrevocable and that the state bar retains continuing jurisdiction with respect to matters involving a past member's conduct

¹The Executive Director states that Nielsen applied for resignation after the dues deadline but before the late fee deadline; that the Board of Governors considered the matter; and that the Board of Governors deems Nielsen current on all membership fees for purposes of this matter.

prior to resignation. See SCR 98(5)(c)-(d). Finally, Nielsen has submitted an affidavit of compliance with SCR 115. See SCR 98(5)(e).

petition satisfies the requirements of SCR 98(5).The Accordingly, we approve attorney Greg R. Nielsen's resignation. SCR 98(5)(a)(2). The petition is hereby granted.
