## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On June 22, 2010, respondent filed a motion to dismiss this appeal for lack of jurisdiction. Specifically, it appears that the order appellant is challenging is not a final, appealable judgment. See NRAP 3A(b)(1) (providing for an appeal from a final judgment in an action or proceeding). A final judgment is one that disposes of all issues presented in the case and leaves nothing for the future consideration of the district court except for post-judgment issues such as attorney fees and costs. Lee v. GNLV Corp., 116 Nev. 424, 996 P.2d 416 (2000). Accordingly, as it appears that a final judgment has not been entered in the underlying case, we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal. We therefore grant respondent's motion and dismiss this appeal.
