This is an original petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Appellant appears to be challenging loss of good time credits due to a disciplinary action. We have reviewed the documents submitted in this matter, and without deciding upon the merits of any claims, we decline to exercise original jurisdiction in this matter. NRS 34.160; NRS 34.170. A challenge to the loss of good time credits must be raised in a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus in the district court in the first instance.¹ NRS 34.724(2)(c); NRS 34.738(1). Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
