ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

When appellant's notice of appeal was filed in this court on June 11, 2010, he was mailed a civil proper person appeal statement and other documents, including instructions advising appellant that he was required to file his appeal statement within 40 days from the date his appeal was filed in this court. See ADKT No. 385 (Order Establishing Pilot Program in Civil Appeals, June 10, 2005), Exhibit A (Instructions for Civil Litigants Without Attorneys). The instructions further explained that if appellant failed to file the appeal statement by that date, this court would dismiss the appeal. Id.

Appellant's appeal statement was due on July 21, 2010. To date, appellant has not filed an appeal statement or otherwise responded to this court's directive. Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal as abandoned.
