ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is a proper person appeal from a district court dismissal of a complaint alleging conspiracy and fraud in connection with appellant's marriage, divorce, and child support obligation. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; David A. Hardy, Judge.

Because appellant's complaint raised untimely arguments that challenged prior judgments, the district court dismissed the action for lack of jurisdiction. NRCP 12(h)(3). In appellant's civil proper person appeal statement, he makes no argument that the district court had jurisdiction to consider his complaint. See Edwards v. Emperor's Garden Rest., 122 Nev. 317, 330 n.38, 130 P.3d 1280, 1288 n.38 (2006) (noting that

this court need not consider an issue not cogently argued by a party).

Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.¹
