

ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a plea of nolo contendre, of battery with the use of a deadly weapon and burglary. Sixth Judicial District Court, Lander County; Richard Wagner, Judge.

Appellant Lawson Guy Steve contends that the district court erred by denying his presentence motion to withdraw his guilty plea because the district court was involved in the plea negotiations in violation of this court's holding in <u>Cripps v. State</u>, 122 Nev. 764, 137 P.3d 1187 (2006). We disagree.

Immediately after the plea negotiations were completed, the district court stated that it had participated in the negotiations in an offthe-record discussion and agreed to impose concurrent sentences. The district court clearly erred by not recording its discussion with counsel. See id. at 770, 137 P.3d at 1191 (expressly prohibiting all off-the-record discussions between the judge and the parties regarding plea negotiations). We conclude, however, that Steve has failed to demonstrate that any reversible error occurred. See id. at 771, 137 P.3d at 1192. Although the district court failed to make a record of its participation, the record before this court does not indicate that its participation was

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA improper. <u>See id.</u> at 770-71, 137 P.3d at 1191 (allowing the court to express whether it is inclined to follow the parties' sentencing recommendation). Accordingly, there was no "erroneous participation" that could have been "reasonably . . . viewed as having been a material factor affecting [Steve's] decision to plead guilty." <u>Id.</u> at 771, 137 P.3d at 1192 (quoting <u>U.S. v. Daigle</u>, 63 F.3d 346, 349 (5th Cir. 1995)) (discussing the applicable harmless-error inquiry), and we

ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.
