ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court denying a "motion to correct clerical mistakes." Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Michael Villani, Judge.

In his motion filed on June 4, 2010, appellant claimed that his sentence was illegal because the amended judgment of conviction contained errors and he claimed that the State of Nevada had failed to serve a copy of the amended judgment of conviction on the Nevada Department of Corrections. Appellant has already raised claims substantially similar to these claims in two motions and a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus, and this court rejected those claims.²

The doctrine of law of the case prevents further litigation of these claims and cannot be avoided by a more detailed and precisely focused argument. See Hall v State, 91 Nev. 314, 316, 535 P.2d 797, 799 (1975). To the extent that appellant sought to correct an allegedly illegal sentence, appellant failed to demonstrate that his sentence was facially illegal or that the district court was without jurisdiction in this matter. Edwards v. State, 112 Nev. 704, 708, 918 P.2d 321, 324 (1996). Therefore, the district court did not err in denying the motion. Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
