ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges an order of the district court that denied petitioner's motion to require real party in interest (1) to advance attorney's fees to petitioner's attorney in an amount equal to the amount real party in interest has deposited with his attorney; (2) to pay petitioner temporary child support; and (3) to allow petitioner equal access to the community resources.

We have considered this petition and the answer thereto, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. Accordingly, we deny the petition. See NRAP 21(b); State ex rel. Dep't Transp. v. Thompson, 99 Nev. 358, 662 P.2d 1338 (1983).
