This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court denying a proper person document labeled, "petition to redesignate." In his petition, appellant sought a redesignation of his crime of possession of stolen property from a felony to a misdemeanor because of a change of law enacted after his conviction. Based upon our review of the record on appeal, we conclude that the district court did not err in denying appellant's petition. See NRS 34.724; Jackson v.
