ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks an order directing the district court to grant his motion to withdraw attorney and for production of his file. On October 25, 2010, this court ordered the State to show cause why the petition should not be granted. On November 18, 2010, the State responded that petitioner has obtained new counsel, who has substituted into the case and has filed a receipt for the original file from prior counsel.<sup>1</sup> Because appellant has

<sup>1</sup>The State's argument that the district court did not have jurisdiction to entertain the motion to withdraw counsel because the remittitur from petitioner's direct appeal had not issued, was without merit. The remittitur issued on July 2, 2010, and petitioner filed his motion in the district court on July 14, 2010.
