ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS


This original proper person petition for a writ of mandamus challenges the district court's order denying summary judgment.<sup>1</sup> Having considered the petition, we are not persuaded that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted. NRAP 21(b)(1); Smith v. District Court, 113 Nev. 1343, 950 P.2d 280 (1997) (stating that this court generally refuses to entertain writs challenging orders denying


