

ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL



This is an appeal from a district court order dismissing appellant's post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Steven R. Kosach, Judge.

Our preliminary review of appellant's appeal revealed a potential jurisdictional defect: the district court order did not resolve all of the claims presented in appellant's petition and supplemental petitions. Accordingly, we ordered appellant's counsel to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. We have considered counsel's response to our order to show cause and conclude that we lack jurisdiction to entertain this appeal because the district court has not yet entered a final order resolving all claims in this matter. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.¹
